GUIDELINES for SPECTATORS

Familiarize yourself with the 2026 Route Maps

-- Plan Accordingly : Read the Parking and Road Closure Schedule --

- Be courteous to and follow the directions of Race Officials, Volunteers, Tanglewood Staff and Public Safety Personnel.
****They are there for everyones safety****
- **DOGS are NOT ALLOWED at Tanglewood, Stockbridge Bowl boat ramp or Camp Mah-Kee-Nac. Leave your dogs at home on race day.**
- In the Cycle-to-Paddle transition and the Paddle-to-Running transition areas, **ONLY** Paddling racers, officials, volunteers and Iron/Tin Helpers are permitted on the ramp, beach or in the water. No spectators or unauthorized persons are permitted in this area.
 - **This is a safety matter.**
- **Familiarize yourself with the Parking & Road Closure Schedule**
 - Parking along Hawthorne Road, the causeway and Route 183 between Tanglewood and the boat ramp will be prohibited.
 - Parking for spectators is available at the Tanglewood East Lot.
 - There will be a pedestrian lane along Route 183 to access the boat ramp.
 - **STAY BEHIND THE TRAFFIC CONES** - cyclists will be racing in that area.
 - There will be well marked pedestrian trails from the Lion's Gate lower parking lot.
 - Trail through Bullard Woods to Camp Mah-Kee-Nac
 - Trail through Gould Meadows to the boat ramp and Rte 183*****Refer to the parking/road closures document for details.**
 - Do not park on Kripalu Center property
 - If you park in Gould Meadows on Rte 183, you will not be allowed egress until the last cyclist passes.
 - Tanglewood has offered the use of the path from the Main Gate to the Lion's Gate across the inner grounds.
 - No alcohol or food is allowed between the gates.
 - No bicycles are allowed to be ridden between the gates.
 - Stay on the pathway.
- Portable restrooms will be available at the Price Chopper parking lot in Great Barrington; the boat ramp in Stockbridge; Camp Mah-Kee-Nac and the East Lot of Tanglewood.
- Earbuds/Headphones restrict your awareness of your surroundings. Do not wear them.
- At Camp Mah-Kee-Nac : DO NOT STAND on the bleachers.
- LOST and FOUND for Camp Mah-Kee-Nac will be in the Gazebo near the beach.
LOST and FOUND for Tanglewood will be at the awards tent.
