SAFETY FIRST ! For the safety for racers, spectators, neighbors, volunteers and staff, please **RESPECT** and **FOLLOW** the directions of staff, authorities and volunteers on race day.
This is a celebration in every sense. Let's all celebrate safely and respectfully!

The Josh Billings race committee is grateful for this opportunity to return to Tanglewood. Our partnership with Tanglewood is a privilege we hope to preserve for many years. On race day, we will be sharing the Tanglewood premises with another event. Therefore, we agreed that everyone: racers, spectators and race personnel, will leave before 4:00 PM, including the Lion's Gate lot. The parking lots will be locked at 4:00 PM. Any vehicles remaining in the parking lots at 4:00 PM must be retrieved on Monday.

Parking: Paddlers should park in the Lion's Gate lot on Hawthorne Road. Everyone else should park in the East Gate lot on West Street (Route 183) for the finish line, the kids race and the Bash. Follow the directions of the parking attendants. No vehicles will be allowed to drive into the main gate of Tanglewood.

There will be a connector pathway between the Lion's Gate lot and the Bash area through the Tanglewood inner grounds. Please stay on that pathway so you don't interfere with the other event with which we are sharing the property. The Josh Billings Race Committee will have volunteers along the pathway to guide you. This will be monitored by volunteers and law enforcement officials.

Rules for the Bash:

All alcohol and food purchased at the Bash must be enjoyed only in the Bash area due to strict licensing restrictions.

No dogs or other animals, except certified service dogs, are allowed on the Tanglewood grounds, as well as the Boat Ramp and Camp-Mah-Kee-Nac.

No motorized vehicles, except transport devices used by individuals with mobility impairments.

No cooking, open flames, grilling or fireworks

No smoking or vaping of any substance.

No drones, skateboards, rollerblades or weapons (with or without permit).

Restrooms: Tanglewood is providing use of the restrooms located outside the main gate for the Bash.

The Josh Billings Race Committee will provide port-potties near the Bash area. [Please note: the restrooms inside the main gate are designated solely for the guests of the other event.]

The Josh Billings Race Committee, Camp Mah-Kee-Nac and Tanglewood have the right to remove from the property, anyone not complying with these conditions.

Anti-Harassment Policy

Tanglewood has a zero-tolerance policy for harassment of any kind, including but not limited to race, national origin, gender, gender identity, gender presentation, sexual orientation, age, ability, religion, and citizenship. Harassment includes but is not limited to stalking, verbal or physical intimidation, offensive verbal comments, physical assault and/or battery, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome physical attention. If you are made to feel uncomfortable or unsafe, please immediately report any concerns to Race staff or security personnel so appropriate action can be taken.
